VOTING/NOMINATION PERIODS. The Best Local Theatre Teacher Award Contest 2016, Sponsored by SDCCU (“**Award Contest**”) begins on 05/02/2016 at 8:00 a.m. Pacific Time (“**PT**”) and ends on 05/15/2016 at 11:59 p.m. PT (“**Award Contest Period**”). The one (1) Nominee (defined below) with the most votes on the Site (defined below) during the Award Contest Period will be selected as the grand prize winner and notified on or around 05/16/2016 (“**Winner Selection Date**”) and will be announced publicly at the 2016 Ben Vereen Awards on 05/29/2016, as more fully set forth below. Entry in the Award Contest does not constitute entry into any other promotion, sweepstakes or contest.

ELIGIBILITY. The Award Contest is open to lawful, permanent residents of the United States, 18 years of age or older. Employees, vendors, Board Members, volunteers and consultants of SDCCU and its subsidiaries, and their immediate family members (e.g. parents, children, siblings, spouse) and members of their households (whether related or not) are not eligible to win. Winners of previous Best Local Theatre Teacher Awards are not eligible to win and may not be nominated again. Award Contest is void in Puerto Rico, U.S. territories and possessions, outside of the United States, and where restricted or prohibited by law. Award Contest subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws. SDCCU reserves the right to disqualify anyone who fails to follow these Official Rules or who makes any misrepresentations relative to the Award Contest or redemption of prize. Entries by ineligible persons, fraudulent entries or entries created in error will be disqualified and an alternate entry selected. Nominees, Nominators (defined below), and Voters (defined below) are collectively referred to in these Official Rules as “**Participants**” or a “**Participant**.”

Nominations:

If you (“**Nominator**”) know of a deserving theatre teacher currently employed in San Diego County who has made a positive difference in your life, the life of your child or in your community (each a “**Nominee**”), Nominator can enter him or her in the Award Contest during the Award Contest Period as follows: (1) visit the SDCCU Facebook page (the “**Site**”); (2) fill out and submit the entry form including all information requested such as a narrative description (the “**Submission**”). Entry and voting will close at the end of the Award Contest Period.

When making an entry, each Nominator; must comply with the following requirements (“**Nomination Requirements**”): (1) Nominator may only enter and provide information about a Nominee with the Nominee’s express permission to do so; (2) Nominator may only enter a Nominee who meets the eligibility criteria above and who is a drama or theatre teacher in San Diego County; (3) the Nominee must provide upon request all appropriate clearances, permissions and releases for the Submission (in the event an Participant cannot provide all required releases, Sponsor reserves the right, in Sponsor’s sole discretion, to disqualify the applicable Submission, or seek to secure the releases and clearances for Sponsor’s benefit, or allow the applicable Submission to remain in the Award Contest); and (4) the Submission must not include any content that is obscene, pornographic, libelous or otherwise objectionable. Any Submission that, in Sponsor’s good faith judgment, violates the Nomination Requirements will be disqualified. Voting:

Once a Nominee is entered, the Submission will be reviewed by the Sponsor. If, at the sole discretion of the Sponsor, the Nomination is deemed to meet the eligibility requirements, the Submission will be approved and appear as a Nominee on the Site within one (1) business day. Facebook users can vote for their favorite Nominee (each person who votes, a “**Voter**”) on the Site during the Award Contest Period.

Limit one (1) vote person per day.

Presentation of the Best Local Theatre Teacher Award:

The announcement of the grand prize winning Nominee with the most votes and who will receive the Best Local Drama Teacher Award will take place at the 2016 Ben Vereen Awards San Diego Competition on Sunday, May 29, 2016 at the Balboa Theatre. The results will also be posted on the Site.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY. SDCCU is not responsible for, and will not accept, lost, late, incomplete, delayed, damaged, destroyed, deleted, erased, stolen or illegible entries. SDCCU will not verify receipt of entries or votes for Participants. Mechanically reproduced entries or votes will not be accepted. SDCCU assumes no responsibility for any error, problem or malfunction (human, technical, or otherwise) which may occur in the creation, maintenance or processing of Award Contest entries or votes, or which prevents entries or votes from being created. The Site database clock is the official timekeeper for the Award Contest. SDCCU will make its best reasonable effort to contact the winner. If any potential prize winner does not respond to prize notification attempts within two (2) days of the first notification attempt (or such shorter time as exigencies may require), is found to be ineligible, or if he or she has not complied with these Official Rules or declines the applicable prize for any reason prior to award, such potential prize winner will be disqualified and an alternate winner may be selected. Sponsor may successively attempt to contact up to two (2) potential prize winners in accordance with such procedure, and if there is still no confirmed prize winner after such attempts have been made, if any, the applicable prize may go unawarded.
